PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE -
MINUTES
JULY 11, 2022

CALL BOARD MEETING TO ORDER: Meeting was called to order by Trustee Mike Constant at 6:41 PM. Trustee Kula motioned for Trustee Constant to be President Pro Tem. Trustee Quirk seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Quirk-Aye, Gayhart-Aye, Kula-Aye, and Constant-Aye. Motion carried. Roll call was taken showing the following:

Present: Trustees Sarah Quirk, Steve Gayhart, Russell Kula, and Mike Constant. Quorum Established.

Absent: Michele Greene-Larsen and Walter Rainford.

Also Present: Village Clerk Elizabeth Losiniecki, Deputy Clerk Kathy Michaels, Attorney Tait Lundgren, Treasurer Dave Maroo and Members of the Public.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The pledge to the flag was recited.

OPEN HEARING FOR THE APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR FY 2023

President Pro Tem Constant opened the public hearing and asked for public comment.

There were no comments from the public.

Trustee Constant stated that TEST sent a letter stating that they will be imposing an 8.6% monthly inflation surcharge beginning July 1, 2022. He also stated he did not know if our contract allowed for such an increase. However, to be on the safe side, he suggests increasing the appropriations for Professional Services for Water and Sewer from \$200,000 to \$220,000 (10%). Constant recommends approval of the FY 2023 appropriations ordinance.

Trustee Kula asked if there was any money this year for road repairs. Village Treasurer Dave Maroo stated there was no MFT money available for any road projects this year.
