AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2023
AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2024

BE IT NOW AND HEREBY ORDAINED by the President and Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Hinckley, DeKalb County, Illinois that:

SECTION 1. That the total amount of appropriations for all corporate purposes except for tax increment financing districts and debt service funds legally made to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year is hereby ascertained to be the sum of Three Hundred Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen dollars (\$316,815.00).

SECTION 2. That the sum of Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand Six Hundred Ninety dollars (\$315,690.00) Being the total of appropriations debt service funds herein legally made which are to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the Village of Hinckley for the following purposes: Corporate Police Protection, Street and Bridge, Illinois Municipal Retirement, Social Security, Tort (Judgements), Municipal Auditing, School Crossing Guard, Workers Compensation and Unemployment Insurance to be appropriated for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2023 and ending April 30, 2024. The specific amounts as levied for the various purposes are as follows:

SECTION 3. That the sum of Five Hundred Sixty Five dollars (\$565.00) being the total of appropriations debt service funds herein legally made which are to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the Village of Hinckley for the following

purposes: Hinckley Special Service Area #1 to be appropriated for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2023 and ending April 30, 2024. The specific amounts as levied for the various purposes are as follows:

A. Special Service Area #1 \$ 565.00

SECTION 4. That the sum of Five Hundred Sixty dollars (\$560.00) being the total of appropriations debt service funds herein legally made which are to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the Village of Hinckley for the following purposes: Hinckley Special Service Area #2 to be appropriated for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2023 and ending April 30, 2024. The specific amounts as levied for the various purposes are as follows:

A. Special Service Area #2 \$ 560.00

SECTION 5. That the summary of the aforesaid levies hereby made in the Ordinance is as follows:

SECTION 6. That the total of Three Hundred Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen dollars (\$316,815.00) ascertained as aforesaid be and the same is hereby levied and assessed on all property subject to taxation within the Village of Hinckley according to the value of said property as the same as assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for the current year.

SECTION 7. That this Levy Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the procedure set forth in the Illinois Municipal Code.

SECTION 8. That there is hereby certified to the County Clerk of DeKalb County Illinois the several sums aforesaid constituting the total amount of Three Hundred Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen dollars (\$316,815.00) which total amount the Village of Hinckley required to be raised by tax levy of the current fiscal year of the Village and the Legal Director of Village is hereby ordered and directed to file with the County Clerk

of DeKalb County, a certified copy of this Ordinance on or before the time required by law.

SECTION 9. That all other orders, resolutions or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists, and this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publications, as provided by Law.


SECTION 10. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to publish this Ordinance.





**TRUTH IN TAXATION
CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE**


I, Sarah Quirk, President Pro Tem of the Village of Hinckley, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Hinckley, Illinois, and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

Check One of the Choices Below:

1. The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law.
2. The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.
3. The proposed aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a hearing was not held. The adopted aggregate tax levy exceeded 5% of the prior year's extension and a notice was published within 15 days of its adoption in accordance with the Truth in Taxation Law.
4. The adopted levy exceeded the amount stated in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the Truth in Taxation Law.

This certificate applies to the 2023-2024 levy ordinance.
