New Business

Small Business Group Update- (Website Project) Amie and Rylie reported that they are working on what the content of the 6 webpages will be. Downtown Group Update- (Mosaic Mural Project)- Ardith passed around a sample drawing of the mural and spoke about the details in the final drawing. She spoke about concerns with the placement of the handicap sign that is on the building and whether it can be placed on a pole. We hope to get the mural on the agenda for a September village board meeting for approval of design.

Family Support Group Update- (Digital Signs Project)- Travis reported that he is meeting with the Hinckley Library to discuss the intergovernmental agreement. Waubensee CC is also interested and is in discussion with Travis. He has not heard from the Hinckley Fire District or Squaw Grove Township. Travis reported that he is filling out a DCCF Grant for \$7500 under the HBR CUSD #429 for the digital signs and is waiting for a letter of recommendation from the Village of Hinckley.
