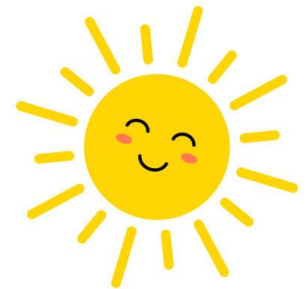




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## Hinckley Parks and Recreation

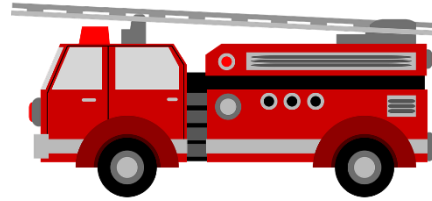

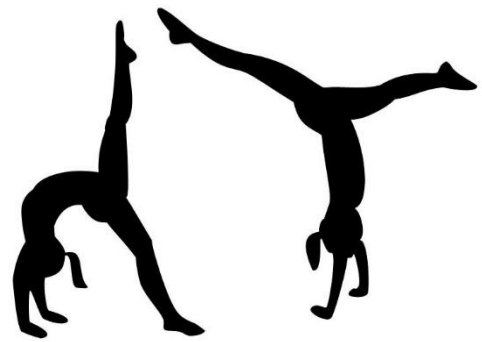

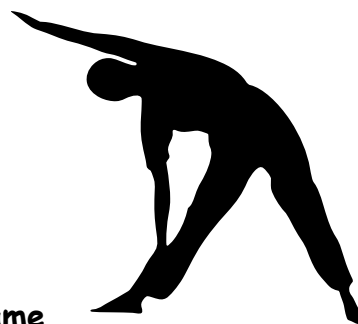
### Summer Yoga Flow

- Price: \$10/class or \$15/2 participants from the same household

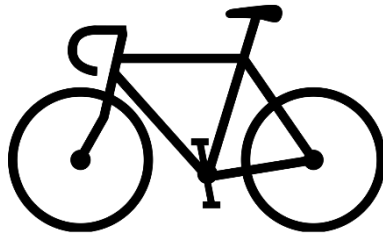
• You can register for each session (session 1 and/or session 2) ahead of time at the Hinckley Village Office or if you want to pay for each class, each time, you are able to do that also.
